RAPE IS BEING USED AS A WEAPON OF WAR AGAINST WOMEN AND GIRLS IN SUDAN

Since April 2023, Sudan has been engulfed in a brutal civil war. Tens of thousands of people have been killed and more than 12 million have been forced to flee. Every day, people struggle to survive without food, clean water, healthcare, or access to information.

Women and girls are particularly affected. Amnesty has documented how widespread sexual violence has been used systematically to humiliate, control, and forcibly displace entire communities.

Rape, gang rape, sexual slavery, and other forms of sexual violence committed in connection with armed conflict are serious violations of international humanitarian law and constitute war crimes.

Take action and sign our petition to the UN Security Council, calling on them to act to ensure that the sexual violence stops immediately. Survivors must receive support, care, and justice, and women's voices must be heard in efforts toward peace and accountability.
