In connection with recruitment, recruitment coordinators will hold information meetings with the aim of starting new groups locally.

NORDIC YOUTH CONFERENCE

Nordic Youth Conference is back in its physical form for the first time since 2019! This time, a driven and motivated delegation of 10 Swedish Amnesty youths went to Finland, where they met delegations from Iceland, Norway, Denmark, the Faroe Islands, and of course from the host country itself. Activism and learning were on the agenda: "You gain a lot of knowledge from seeing how other activists do and how they work with action cases in the other countries," says Anela Rec, who supported Amnesty for a long time before she became an activist almost a year ago.



For a whole week, the participants have shared experiences, learned about this year's theme - Israel's apartheid against Palestinians - and ended with an action in Helsinki (read more about it on Amnesty Finland's instagram).

During the conference, among others, the Write-for-Freedom case was visited by Janna Jihad, who talked about her situation and activism (via link), and Syksy Räsänen, who gave a lecture about the situation of Palestinians in Israel. Milla Durnell looks back on an inspiring week with many new contacts:
